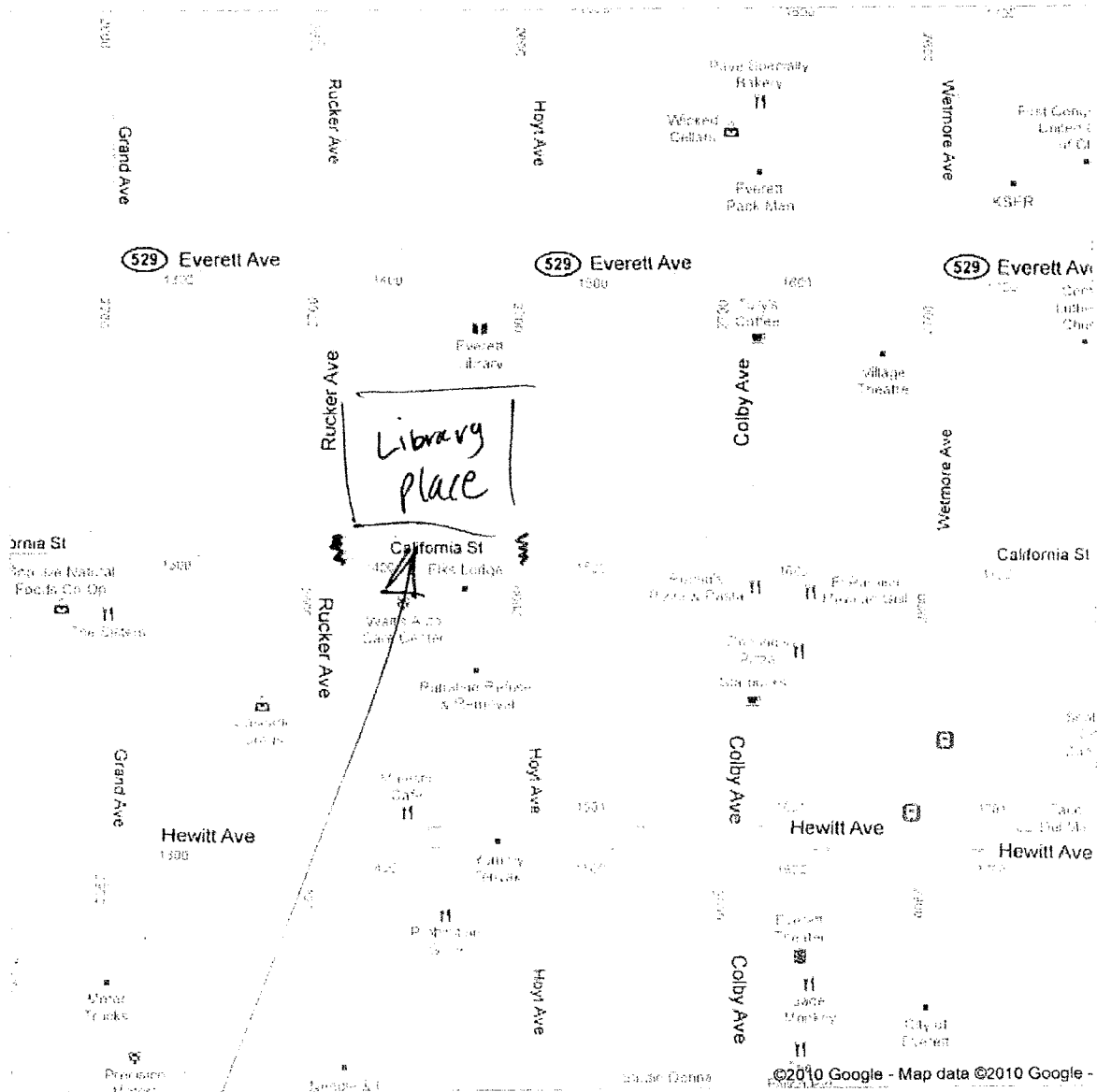

Permit Conditions

General.

1. The street closure area will only be open to the public from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on March 11, 2010. Street barricades will be available at the two intersections, and will be placed by Library Place to block intersections as approved on the attached street closure plan at 11:00 a.m. Cars parked in the street closure area will not be towed by Everett Police Department. Library Place may block off parking in the street closure area beginning at 6:00 a.m. with appropriate barricades.
2. There shall be no fee of any kind charged or assessed the public for attending the event.
3. Library Place may not represent or imply that the event is City sponsored or sanctioned.
4. At its sole option, City may verify concurrences by adjoining property owners; lack of concurrence by any adjoining property owner may be cause for revocation or non-issuance of permit.
5. Permit may be revoked at any time after issuance if, in the sole opinion of the City staff, satisfactory compliance with permit conditions is not achieved or maintained.
6. Material changes to Library Place's plan presented to the city as of March 2, 2010 may only be made by Library Place with the City's approval. In its sole discretion, the City may withhold approval. Library Place acknowledges that such changes should be submitted sufficiently in advance to allow the City adequate time to review the proposed changes.
7. Foot traffic and pedestrian access to business establishments in the street closure area may not be blocked or impeded.
8. In the event any amendment or adoption of an ordinance takes effect before or during the event, Library Place shall comply with the requirements of such ordinance, even if such ordinance establishes different requirements than those described in these conditions. These permit conditions will be deemed to be amended by such ordinance.

Health/Safety

9. Library Place will provide staff in the immediate area of the street closure in order to open street access to any emergency vehicle as may be needed. Staff will also be available to allow any parked vehicles within the street closure area to exit once the closure has been set.
10. Library Place must clean up; the City will not provide cleaning equipment or labor. All clean up will be completed prior to street opening, but no later than 3:00 p.m. Library Place will be charged for any fees related to clean-up if not completed to the satisfaction of the City. The City Street Department will conduct a clean-up inspection.
11. The permit and closures may be suspended or terminated for life/safety reasons or for failure or refusal to timely comply with reasonable direction by city personnel, such as police or fire, or failure to comply with permit conditions.

12. The street closure area is approved as designated on the attached street closure plan.
13. Library Place shall arrange and pay for placement of all necessary barricades and signs.
14. Library Place staff and volunteers will remove all traffic barricades, parking barricades, and signage no later than 3:00 p.m. and place all City barricades and signage at the intersection corner (off street) for pickup by the City.

Risk Management

15. Library Place and its officers must jointly and severally defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from any and all claims of any kind in a form provided or approved by the City Attorney's Office, to be completed by March 10, 2010.
16. Library Place shall be financially responsible and promptly repair any and all damage to the property of the city or third parties, including adjacent property owners.
