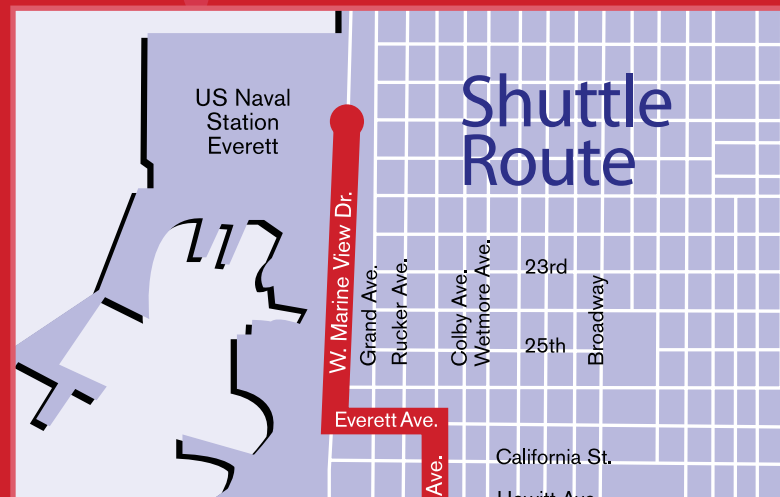
Don't Fuss. Take the Bus.

All Everett Transit buses will be free on July 4th. Regular routes will operate on a Sunday schedule.

Parking at Everett Station

- Over 500 parking spaces available.
- Park in the two lots directly across from Everett Station.
- Additional parking near 34th Street and Smith Avenue (south of the bus bays).

Customers familiar with Everett Transit may find it more convenient to use our regular route service to get around town. July 4th Everett Transit will be operating free on a Sunday service schedule.
