Combined with locking your car doors, rolling up your windows, and removing all personal belongings from your vehicle, a steering wheel locking device (such as the Club) can be an effective auto theft deterrent. An auto thief can easily see the Club –even before they break out a window or begin prying on your door locks. The device is difficult to remove and makes it more difficult for a thief to steal your car.

The Everett Police Department is pleased to offer the auto Club for \$10.86 (checks only please). The Club normally sells for about \$35. Clubs can be purchased directly at the Everett Police Department. The main police station is located at 3002 Wetmore Avenue. Auto Theft Prevention Checklist:

- All car doors locked**
- All windows are rolled up**
- All personal belongings have been removed**
- Vehicle is parked in well-lighted area**
- Vehicle is parked in high-visibility location (avoid isolated areas)**
- Anti-theft device on (Club, alarm system, kill-switch)**
